**Class Options:** \$6 per gun (\$2 per 50) high score, ties divide

**Two Person teams:** \$3/ person/ gauge. High team, ties shoot off

Teams grouped by 2 classes: Class I: A avg and above, Class II: B avg. and below.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Squads will not be called, only reasonable delays will be permitted. All ties will be shot off by doubles at stations 3, 4 & 5 miss and out by station. Reloads permitted per Rule 1-B-2. Contestants and all spectators assume all risks from accidents occurring on the grounds. Eye and ear protection is required. Orange dome targets. All machine adjustments will be hooped.

Management reserves the right to modify this program or reject any entry it considers to be a detriment to the harmony of the shoot. Ammunition may be purchased at the club. Some R.V. spaces are available.
